Peace be with you today! May God fill you up with goodness and grace as you come to worship today!

Before the AFL came into being I used to enjoy going to the Adelaide Oval to watch the SANFL finals and grand finals that were played there.

However, on one occasion when I attended a final being played at Adelaide Oval, I found myself surrounded by crowds of people barracking for the opposition and so when I cheered on one of the players from the team I was barracking for, it was suggested to me that I was in the wrong place and perhaps I should think of moving elsewhere. So I took that advice and found a place where I was among supporters barracking for my own team.

Well in the Bible reading from Luke's Gospel set for today, a man says to Jesus, "I will follow you wherever you go". In reply to him Jesus states: "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head".

And when I thought about that answer of Jesus I realised that it was true. Jesus never owned any property nor did he ever build a house for himself, he simply relied on God to provide all the accommodation that he needed. But the statement of Jesus referring to the fact that he had nowhere to lay his head was also reflective of the fact that his true home wasn't here in this world, he didn't belong here, but his true home was in heaven.

Of course the fact that the true home of Jesus was in heaven, is also quite true for us as his followers. In other words as followers of Jesus we don't really 'belong' to this earth. No, as followers of Jesus this reading from Luke reminds us that we have a true home in heaven - our future lies with God in the Kingdom of God, a very different place than what we experience here on this earth.
